National Flute Association Convention 2015



In August of 2015, 2,500 flutists flocked to Washington DC for a flute-fest like none other. The National Flute Association convention was held on August 13 – 16. This huge gathering was a delight for the ears, the heart and the brain.

The convention opened with the Capital City Flute Orchestra concert. There were 220 flutists, including 10 contrabasses, 26 bass flutes, 38 alto flutes and 166 C flutes. Sharyn Byer conducted the group in 2 world premieres and one NFA premiere. It was a thrill to hear so many flutists making music together.

There were at least 30 Atlanta flutists who attended and performed. Everyone enjoyed being part of the great flute party.

There flute choirs were playing in the lobby 3 times each day and on flute choir showcases. Kelly Via's Mercer University Flute Choir performed on a showcase. The Flute Choir of Atlanta, conducted by Kathy Farmer played a lobby concert which featured world premieres of *Summer Insomnia* by Nicole Chamberlain and *A Celebration for All Seasons* by Kathy Farmer.

Nicole Chamberlain and her sister Gay Lynn Westover gave an informative presentation "When Tooting Your Flute is a Pain in Your Neck". Together they described problems that arise for flutists as they practice and suggested some strategies to alleviate or prevent neck trouble. The room was packed and the audience was very engaged and interested. It was an important part of the educational portion of the NFA program.

The Gala concerts were especially wonderful. We heard the Old Guard Fife and Drum Corps. We watched Hilary Abigana of the Fourth Wall, play her flute while riding upside down on her partner's back. We were treated to solos by flute legends, Harvey Solberger, Paula Robison, Lorna McGee and Mark Sparks as well as presentations by relative newcomers, Aaron Goldman, Demarre McGill, Irina Stachinskaya and Shigenori Kudo. Atlanta Symphony Piccoloist, Carl Hall performed the Vivaldi Concerto in C with the US Army Field Band accompanying on the final Gala. There was so much wonderful music, it is impossible to tell of it all.

This was one of the best planned and executed conventions in a long time. It's a musical experience all of us who attended will treasure for a long time.

Flute Choir Extravaganza 10th Anniversary Concert


A Special Surprise Awaits!

Sixteenth Annual Young Artist Competition

The Atlanta Flute Club announces its sixteenth annual Young Artist competition. The competition is open to full-time high school and college students who have not reached their thirtieth (30th) birthday. Applicants must be members of the Atlanta Flute Club and be current in their dues obligations (dues may be included when sending in application if not already paid). A preliminary CD audition is required. A committee will judge the preliminary audition, and three finalists will be chosen to compete at the AFC Flute Fair in February, 2016. Prizes are as follows: **First place - \$1000, Second place - \$700, and Third place - \$300.** The First place winner will be required to present a recital at the 2017 Flute Fair. Please note that finalists will be required to register for Flute Fair.

Application Procedure:

- Performer’s application must include a high quality cassette tape or CD (no mp3 format, please). Two pieces shall be required on the preliminary CD: (1) Mozart – Concerto in D Major-1st movement, and (2) a piece of the applicant’s choice, preferably, in a contrasting style. All pieces that require accompaniment shall include same on CD. Please include a cadenza with the Mozart. Recordings shall not exceed 30 minutes in length, and shall not include any identification on the CD.
- A typewritten biographical sketch (one paragraph) should be included with the application.
- A check for the **\$25 CD application fee** must accompany the application. Checks should be made payable to the Atlanta Flute Club.
- Applications must be **postmarked by December 15, 2015**. Finalists will be notified by January 26, 2016. The three finalists will compete at the Flute Fair, each presenting a 20-25 minute program, consisting of repertoire of their choice. An accompanist will be provided for the competition unless you prefer to use your own.

Fifth Annual Junior Artist Competition

The **Atlanta Flute Club** is pleased to announce its Junior Artist competition. The competition is open to students through the 10th grade. Applicants must be members of the Atlanta Flute Club and be current in their dues obligations (dues may be included when sending in application if not already paid). A preliminary recorded audition is required. A committee will judge the preliminary audition. Competition finals will be held in January. Students may enter either the Junior Artist Competition or the Young Artist Competition. You may not apply for both.

The winner will have the opportunity to present a 15 minute recital at the 2016 Flute Fair.

Application Procedure:

- Performer's application must include a high quality CD (no mp3 format, please). One piece shall be required on the preliminary CD: (1) Telemann – Sonata in F Major (all movements), with accompaniment. No identification shall be included on the CD itself.
- A typewritten biographical sketch (one paragraph) should be included with the application.
- A check for the **\$15 CD application fee** must accompany the application. Checks should be made payable to the Atlanta Flute Club.
- Applications must be postmarked by **December 11, 2015**. Finalists will compete at a separate event, each presenting a short program consisting of pieces from two contrasting periods. Accompanists must be arranged by each finalist; however, the AFC is happy to provide recommendations.
