Happy New Year! I hope you will resolve to attend all of the wonderful Atlanta Flute Club events in 2016.

Your first opportunity to attend a flute club event in 2016 is at 1:30 pm on January 31, and it is the Junior Artist Competition finals. We've got three talented students competing live at the Alpharetta Steinway Piano Galleries located at 5950 North Point Parkway. These finals are open to anyone who would like to attend. If you've never been to this event, you will really enjoy hearing from these students.

It's a chance to see the next generation of flutists in action. The winner will be performing a short recital for the club in February.

Our big event of the year is the Flute Fair, which will be held on February 20, 2016 at Georgia State University at Perimeter in Clarkston. This is the same location that we've used in past years, but it has a new name due to the merging of Georgia State University and Georgia Perimeter College. In addition to the new name, the school is undergoing some much-needed renovations to the Fine Arts building where we hold our event. The concert hall and lobby are being updated this year, so we are unable to use those parts of our usual facilities. We have plans

in place to work around the renovation. Final details are still being sorted out, so keep an eye on our website and your email. You will receive lots of information about this year's fair in the coming weeks.

We are excited about this year's guest artist, Viviana Guzman. She is dynamic in her personality, and performance, and will be presenting a masterclass and recital that you won't want to miss. We also have many excellent vendors coming to our exhibit hall—some new faces, and some old friends. They will have lots of flutes, music, repair services, and flute-related items available. We will hear performances from last year's Young Artist Competition winner, this year's Junior Artist Competition winner, and the Middle and High School Honors Flute Choirs. There will be a slightly revised schedule from past years, but we believe it to be an improvement. Again, keep an eye on your email, and our website for coming details.

On May 28, 2016, we will hold our Spring Event at Greater Atlanta Christian School. This event will feature guest artist Angela Jones-Reus, Professor of Flute at the University of Georgia. She will give a recital, lecture, and masterclass, with a focus on college audition preparation. Details are still being finalized, but you can expect to see more information about our Spring Event at Flute Fair, as well as on our website.

It is my hope that you will attend each of these events. I look forward to seeing you there, to meeting each one of you, and to a flute-filled 2016.

The Atlanta Flute Fair 2016 is almost here! February 20 is going to be a wonderful day of all things flute. Viviana Guzman, our Guest Artist will delight and amaze you with her on point teaching and her wonderful recital. In addition, we will have the Young Artist Competition Finals, a recital by Hannah Hammel, the 2015 YA Winner, a mini-recital by the Winner of the Junior Artist Competition and a concert by the AFC Middle and High School Honors Choirs. Kelly McKinney will be directing the Middle School Honors Choir and Jessica Sherwood will be directing the High School Honors Choir. The day will also feature a flute choir reading session, directed by Nicole Chamberlain, and a fantastic warm-up session lead by Dr. Andree Martin. There will be exhibits with flutes for sale, flute music and flute accessories throughout the day. You will be greatly entertained and educated by the flute-filled feast of music!

Because of renovations in the lobby and auditorium at Georgia State University at Perimeter, the performances will be held in the Lecture Hall in the library, which is just a short walk from the Fine Arts Building on the covered walkway next to Parking Lot 3. The reading session and warm-ups will be held in the Fine Arts Building on the 2nd floor, accessible by elevator. The exhibits and honors choir rehearsals will be held on the ground floor as usual. Registration will be in the lobby just inside the doors on the ground floor, best reached from the parking lot behind the Fine Arts Building.

***AFC Hosts Recital, Talk, and Masterclass Event,
“Applying to Music School: the Audition”

One of Georgia's star musicians and teachers, Angela Jones-Reus has really been there -as soloist, chamber artist, orchestral player, teacher, and student. She started playing flute at the age of twelve, and she showed great promise, later, as a student at the North Carolina School of the Arts and the Juilliard School. Her succeeding career reads like a story book: sole recipient of the Fulbright-Hayes scholarship in music; recitals or solo performances before orchestras in Italy, Germany, Switzerland, England, Brazil, Japan, Poland, and the USA; appearances beside Rampal, Baker, and Zukerman; principal positions with the Stuttgart Philharmonic Orchestra and the Grand Teton Festival Orchestra; and she has been a regular guest in the section of the Berlin Philharmonic since 1999. Thus, her experience uniquely qualifies her to teach serious students of the flute at the University of Georgia's Hugh Hodgson School of Music.



The Atlanta Flute Club is pleased to report that Ms Jones-Reus has graciously agreed to present a recital, talk, and masterclass event with considerations regarding the application to music school, especially the audition. The event is to begin at 9am on Saturday 28 May, 2016. The event will be housed in the Clifton Jones Theater of the Sarah D Williams Performing Arts Center at Greater Atlanta Christian School (1575 Indian Trail Road, Norcross GA 30093).

The Atlanta Flute Club welcomes all to attend this event. Admission for all or part of the day is as follows:

- Flutists – Atlanta Flute Club membership and \$30.00
- Non-flutists \$30.00
- Greater Atlanta Christian School Faculty and Students – Free.

Please note that there will be room for six students in the masterclass, allotted a nominal twenty minutes each. The six will be chosen from interested individuals submitting an application. The application steps are

1. you must have current Atlanta Flute Club membership – renew, if necessary
2. state your interest and explain your musical life in email to Alan Horne alain.de.jeau.ornes@gmail.com (see the following comments about what is appropriate in this explanation)
3. record audition music un-accompanied (see the following lists for repertoire) on CD and mail the CD to Alan Horne, 2154 Dry Pond Road NW, Monroe GA 30656

Applications completed after 15 April, 2016 will be ignored. Successful applicants will be notified by 1 May, 2016.

“Applying to Music School: the Audition” (continued)

In the explanation, please discuss your background with the flute – methods, your repertoire, teachers who have taught you, ensembles you have played in, and any competitions you have been in. Additionally, give some idea of where you want to go with the flute – music school, an active avocation, a professional career, etc.

The repertoire for the audition CD should include the first two movements of a Mozart flute concerto, two contrasting movements of a Bach sonata, the first four bars of Debussy’s “Prelude a l’apres-midi d’un faune”, and Beethoven’s Leonore Overture No. 3, measures 328 to 360. The repertoire for the masterclass can be any standard flute repertoire required for auditions for a music school in the USA.

In any case, “Applying to Music School: the Audition” promises a fascinating recital featuring fluid sonority, powerfully projected, a thought-provoking commentary on heading towards music school, and a fun masterclass with some of the region’s most talented young people!

And last but not least, the AFC wishes to thank Keren Barr and North Georgia Band Instrument Service for their support making this event possible! Keren will be present, showing Muramatsu flutes and offering some technical support for flutists.

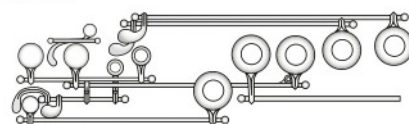
