





## ***Fifteenth Annual Young Artist Competition***

The **Atlanta Flute Club** announces its fifteenth annual Young Artist competition. The competition is open to full-time high school and college students who have not reached their thirtieth (30th) birthday. Applicants must be members of the Atlanta Flute Club and be current in their dues obligations (dues may be included when sending in application if not already paid). A preliminary tape audition is required. A committee will judge the preliminary audition, and three finalists will be chosen to compete at the AFC Flute Fair in February, 2015. Prizes are as follows: **First place - \$1000, Second place - \$700, and Third place - \$300.** The First place winner will be featured in recital at the 2016 Flute Fair. Please note that finalists will be required to register for Flute Fair.

### **Application Procedure:**

- Performer's application must include a high quality cassette tape or CD (no mp3 format, please). Two pieces shall be required on the preliminary tape: (1) Mozart – Concerto in G Major-1st movement, and (2) a piece of the applicant's choice, preferably, in a contrasting style. All pieces that require accompaniment shall include same on tape. Please include a cadenza with the Mozart. Tapes shall not exceed 30 minutes in length, and shall not include any identification on the tape.
- A typewritten biographical sketch (one paragraph) should be included with the application.
- A check for the **\$25 tape application fee** must accompany the application. Checks should be made payable to the Atlanta Flute Club.
- Applications must be **postmarked by December 15, 2014**. Finalists will be notified by January 26, 2015. The three finalists will compete at the Flute Fair, each presenting a 20-25 minute program, consisting of repertoire of their choice. An accompanist will be provided for the competition unless you prefer to use your own.

### ***Fourth Annual Junior Artist Competition***

The **Atlanta Flute Club** is pleased to announce its Junior Artist competition. The competition is open to students through the 10th grade. Applicants must be members of the Atlanta Flute Club and be current in their dues obligations (dues may be included when sending in application if not already paid). A preliminary recorded audition is required. A committee will judge the preliminary audition. Competition finals will be held in January. Students may enter either the Junior Artist Competition or the Young Artist Competition. You may not apply for both.

**The winner will have the opportunity to present a 15 minute recital at the 2015 Flute Fair.**

#### **Application Procedure:**

- Performer's application must include a high quality CD (no mp3 format, please). One piece shall be required on the preliminary tape: (1) Telemann – Sonata in F Major (all movements), with accompaniment. No identification shall be included on the tape itself.
- A typewritten biographical sketch (one paragraph) should be included with the application.
- A check for the **\$15 tape application fee** must accompany the application. Checks should be made payable to the Atlanta Flute Club.
- Applications must be postmarked by **December 10, 2014**. Finalists will compete at a separate event, each presenting a short program consisting of pieces from two contrasting periods. Accompanists must be arranged by each finalist; however, the AFC is happy to provide recommendations.

## 2015 Atlanta Flute Club Honors Choir Application

All 6th through 12th grade flutists are invited to submit a recorded audition for the 2015 Honors Flute Choirs. Students who are not currently members of the Atlanta Flute Club must join to audition. Students who are members for 2014 will need to pay membership dues for 2015 before the 2015 Flute Fair. All who audition must pay Flute Fair and audition fees in advance.

### Requirements:

---

#### **The Middle School Honors Flute Choir (Grades 6-8)**

Middle School All State major scales (F, Bb, Eb, Ab) **AND** arpeggios. Extra credit will be given for playing Bb & Ab 2 octaves. Chromatic Scale: play up and down from Low C to High F. Extra credit will be given for increased range. Required All-state audition piece (both lyrical and technical) available at gmea.org OR Selected Studies page 20 entire piece with the DC.

---

#### **The Senior High School Honors Flute Choir (Grades 9-12)**

Major scales required are C, G, Db and Gb **AND** arpeggios. Play range and articulation as they are listed for All State. Chromatic Scale: play up and down from Low C to High C. Required All-State audition piece (both lyrical and technical) available at gmea.org OR 24 Concert Studies page 67 and 68, Mozart Concerto in G Major, measures 31-91. Please eliminate the multi measure rests and play without accompaniment.

---

The judges are listening for tone, musicianship and technical proficiency. Either piece is acceptable to judge these qualities; choice of piece will not affect the outcome. The scales are available at gmea.org. Please record in the order listed. The Major Scales must be first followed by the Chromatic ending with required piece. **No editing within an individual excerpt. The student may stop the recording between the scales, chromatic and the etudes.** There must be no speaking or identification on the recording. Only the outside box should have the student's name on it. ***DO NOT PUT YOUR NAME ON THE RECORDING!!!*** There is a required \$5 audition fee. Also include a short typewritten biographical sketch. (Included in the form on the next page)

***CD recordings ONLY***  
***(mp3 format, mini discs or cassettes will NOT be judged)***

Audition recordings must be received by midnight **January 15, 2015**. AFC cannot be responsible for lost or late recordings. Late recordings will be disqualified, so mail early!

If chosen for the AFC Honors Flute Choirs, members will be required to rehearse on Friday evening, February 20 and during the Flute Fair on Saturday, February 21, 2015. The concert is on Saturday afternoon, February 21, 2015. Both rehearsals and the concert will be held at Clarkston Campus, Georgia Perimeter College.
